Rutgers Center for Corporate Law and Governance Fellowship Program

The Rutgers Center for Corporate Law and Governance seeks eight Research Fellows to be affiliated with the Center for the 2015-2016 academic year. Four students will be selected from the Newark campus and four students from the Camden campus. Professor Chrystin Ondersma, the Center's Research Director, will supervise research and meet regularly with the Research Fellows, in-person or virtually. The Fellowship Program will appear as a Corporate Governance Fellowship on your transcript. The Fellowship will be one credit per semester, and Fellows are required to devote at least five hours per week to research. Research activities are anticipated to include the following:

- 1) Researching current issues in business law, with special emphasis on developments in New Jersey corporate law
- 2) Developing research that compares New Jersey corporate law with the corporate law of other states, especially New York and Delaware
- 3) Presenting this research in the form of papers, reports, and/or blog entries that will be posted on the Center's website
- 4) Designing and pursuing other research projects in the fields of business, commercial, and/or consumer law

Rigorous research standards will apply. Fellows will attend a weekly meeting with Professor Ondersma where they will present the progress of their research and discuss research plans for the upcoming week.

The Rutgers Center for Corporate Law and Governance Fellowship Program is competitive. It is preferred that applicants have a GPA of at least 3.5 and an average of at least an A- in the first year legal writing courses. All applicants must submit names of at least two faculty members who have agreed to serve as references. Applicants must submit a resume and unofficial transcript to Professor Chrystin Ondersma at condersma@kinoy.rutgers.edu no later than August 1, 2015. In the body of the e-mail, please explain why you are interested in the program and include the names and contact information of the two faculty members who have agreed to recommend you.
